**Dear Kaiser Families,**

Welcome back to Kaiser School! I'd like to welcome all the returning families, all of our new kindergarten families, and three new teachers. I'm excited to welcome the Mrs. Isa Estrada to the first grade, Ms. Katy Hunter to a 3/4 combination class, and Mr. Donald Toomer as our PE teacher. All three new teachers are highly qualified and experienced, and they are eager to meet your families and get to know your children.

Over the summer we saw the departure of several staff members. Jill Reese, our fifth-grade teacher, has retired, but will be returning occasionally as a new teacher coach. Tom Rust, one of our second grade teachers, has taken a job as principal of Paden Elementary in Alameda. Elizabeth Whittaker, our resource teacher, has moved to Southern California to be near her daughter. Carl Morris, our part-time PE instructor, has taken the opportunity to fill his schedule with more full-time employment. All of these valued members of our family will be sorely missed and we wish them the best in their new adventures.

My focus this year will be on the classrooms and on the instructional program. I will make it a point to get into each classroom every day. In this way we will continue our growth.

I have two themes for the Kaiser learning community this year. The first is "Community and Collaboration" and flows out of the district's direction to improve collaboration among teachers and to reach out to the family communities that we serve. The teachers will have a collaboration period each week during which they will work together to provide equitable curriculum and more focused intervention for the children who need it. My other theme is "Give Us a Day: Year II." I am challenging every parent of every child to be involved inside the school building at least one day this year. What could be more important? Last year we reached a participation rate of nearly 80%!

Finally, I am very proud of the staff's work here which resulted in an award for our school this summer. Based on the results of the Use Your Voice Survey, Kaiser Elementary School has the highest parental satisfaction rate in the district-- a whopping 96.1%! This doesn't mean that we never have problems, but it does show that when we have difficulties we work together to communicate about them and overcome them. I am honored to work again with this community.
