KEEP YOUR CHILD SAFE

Please be aware of your child's safety before and after school. **There is no supervision for Kaiser Elementary students before 8:30 am and after 3:00 pm.** It is the parent's responsibility to watch their child before or after school hours. If a student's legal guardian cannot be available to watch the child, then it is the legal guardian's responsibility to make the necessary arrangements (Adventure Time, caregiver, etc.) to make sure their child is properly supervised. Children are not allowed on the playground before 8:30 am (they need to wait for the teacher to be on the playground first) or after 3:00 pm without proper supervision. We appreciate your cooperation with this matter.

Minutes Summary

I. Approval of Minutes

II. Principal's Report

We had a school clean up event this past Sunday.

A councilman donated 2 Warriors tickets.

Enrollment = 274 today, tomorrow it will be 277.

Clarification: PTA donations for teachers will carry over to the next year if there is surplus.

“Local Control Funding’ is coming to the district. We may see extra funds, especially for free/reduced lunch. The district is considering redoing budget concepts. No further information at this time.

Due to Common Core, our computers will be revamped so that our students can take the SBAT on Chromebooks. OUSD will buy Chromebooks for every school for 3rd/4th/5th grades (test taking grades). Timeline = expected delivery by spring of this year.

III. President’s Report

A fraudulent check (from outside of our school) was written against our PTA account for \$24,580. It was not cashed because we did not have sufficient funds. This is apparently a common fraud. Josh and Jennise handled closing our account and reopening a new one. No money was lost. This matter will be announced to the general school community.

The PTA has received parent feedback regarding adult/child ratio at lunch. We need parent volunteers to improve this ratio.

Finances: Ms. Leonardo has been paid all of the monies owed to her by the PTA. OUSD now owes her her balance. This is being worked out now so that she can receive the rest of her pay.

Communication is important. As a board, let’s strive to be a role model for the school. Help each other and parents direct questions to the appropriate person. For example, direct Financial questions to our Treasurer and Financial Secretary.

We need a garden committee leader.

Jody London will be coming to our next Board Meeting to discuss Common Core.

IV. Financial Reports

1. Financial Secretary Report. See report at the end of minutes. Summary: PTA made \$16,897 from 9/27-10/22

2. Treasurer Report

We need to evaluate our relationship with Bank of the West. We would have been responsible for the fraudulent check had it gone through. We may want to consider a paid service that contacts us for check amounts greater a stated dollar value.

We received a letter from the State of California that they did not receive our taxes (minimal dollar amount). We paid a tax prep person last year, but the money was not transmitted. The preparer is helping us to get the bill paid. Josh discussed the tax issue with Susan Nathan, Peralta PTA Treasurer. She seemed to feel comfortable with our process. The tax preparer also did a preliminary audit and feels like our finances are in decent order. Our taxes this year should be fine.

Note that we will need a twice yearly process audit (compliance related guidelines).

The Harvest Fair went under budget for expenses and over for revenue. Thank you!

V. Reports of Committees

Teachers: The teachers are appreciative of enrichment checks getting processed on time. Josh has organized this. Also, more teachers are planning on joining the PTA.

Membership: The class competition has gained more enthusiasm. See attached numbers. We are making announcements in The Pink and the Yahoo Group. We need an accurate financial account of membership versus donation monies. Thanks yous planned for donations—we are trying to track contact info.

Fundraising. See attached report for full details on past, current, future and rolling fundraisers. Note that the Book Fair is not on the sheet and should be included.

General discussion around direction: do we have too many fundraisers? How can we increase fundraising revenue? Thoughts: too many events can contribute to burn out, drawing from a limited pool of funds. Limiting fundraising takes away from the opportunity to do small things. We have to consider the emotional aspects, community building, and our PTA goals for an event even if it is not a big money-maker. In conclusion, we will evaluate this year's events and think about any changes we may want to make for next year.

We opted not to do the Christmas Tree sale. We like the idea of a student art auction.

VI. Old Business

- a. **Consultants:** Jennise and Daren will create a review sheet for teachers to fill out in January. We are looking into the way some consultants are being paid. We are considering using OUSD as the direct payer through our PTA donation.
- b. **Grant Team update**
Review of grants we are currently working on/exploring seriously. We need input from teacher on the projects they want us to support. We can then ask for specific funding. We ask the PTA teacher rep to bring this request back to the teachers. We would also like to attend their meeting to discuss this request, and we may plan a written survey.
We are considering organizing an art auction.

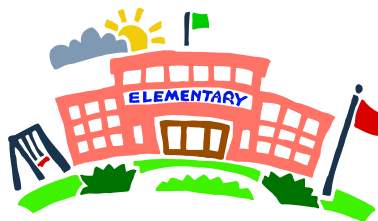
