DROP OFF & PICKUP TIME REMINDERS

DROP OFF:

Please remember that **there is no supervision before 8:30**

<u>AM</u> each morning. Please stay with your child until 8:30 if you arrive to campus earlier, unless they are enrolled in Adventure Time.



PICK UP:

Also, please <u>pick your child up within 15 minutes of dismissal</u>, unless they are in AT. Pick up is between 3:00 - 3:15 (1:30 - 1:45 on Wednesdays and other minimum days.) Kindergarten families may pick up children from the class, but we ask that others please wait outside since busy hallways disrupt learning.

CAFETERIA EXPECTATIONS



Our cafeteria is a busy and active place. 275 students, split between two 20 minute seatings, eat their lunches here. Ms. Shauranda, Mr. Alonzo, Mr. Tolan and Mr. Guikema keep things rolling smooth. The 4th and 5th grade volunteer "Cafeteria Leadership Team" also do a lot to help our Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd graders. As you can imagine, our "safe, mindful and responsible"

expectations are especially important in the cafeteria.

We are asking all families to have a discussion this week at home with your child(ren) about these expectations. Your kids should be able to tell you how they enter the cafeteria, how they keep "inside voices", how they ask permission if they need to get up, how they start eating their lunch right away so they have time to finish it, and how they leave a clean table when they are dismissed. Thank you for your help in helping keep cafeteria time as productive as possible!

The Daisy, Brownie and Junior troops based at Kaiser Elementary will be hosting the annual


One Warm Coat and Toy Drive!
